

Prevention through education

The Rochester Community Schools Police-School Liaison Program began many years ago as a volunteer program called Officer Bill. The value of the program was recognized and with the leadership of the Rochester Area PTA Council, the program has grown to include full-time officers.

The primary responsibilities of the officers are to provide prevention programs in the schools and assist children in some of their more difficult times. Officers are selected from the Oakland County Sheriff's Department and the Rochester Police Department to service the needs of Rochester's elementary, secondary and parochial schools. The philosophy of the program is "Prevention through education."

The uniqueness of the program is the four governmental agencies which provide financial support for the operation of the program:

- City of Rochester Hills
- Charter Township of Oakland
- Rochester Community Schools
- City of Rochester

The program provides up-to-date information in the following areas:

- Child abuse
- Stranger safety
- Vandalism
- Shoplifting
- Drinking and driving
- Substance abuse

District-wide prevention programs are presented at every grade level with officers assisting teachers to enrich specific classroom curriculum.


